
Jackson Township reached new levels of community engagement in 2018, including fire safety education, CPR training, car seat installation, and checks, Stop the Bleed training and an innovative outreach program known as CARES. The Community Assistance Referrals and Assistance Services program adds a non-emergency component to its existing emergency medical services.

CARES is a community paramedicine program designed to build on the trust the JTFD already enjoys within the community by focusing on injury prevention, education and collaboration with local social agencies to help improve the lives of the community's citizens.

The Jackson Township Fire Department maintains a Class 2 classification of its public fire protection capabilities as determined through the Public Protection Classification Program of the Insurance Services Office, placing the department in the top 1.5% of the more than 49,000 fire departments in the United States.










EMS & Fire Runs by Month














